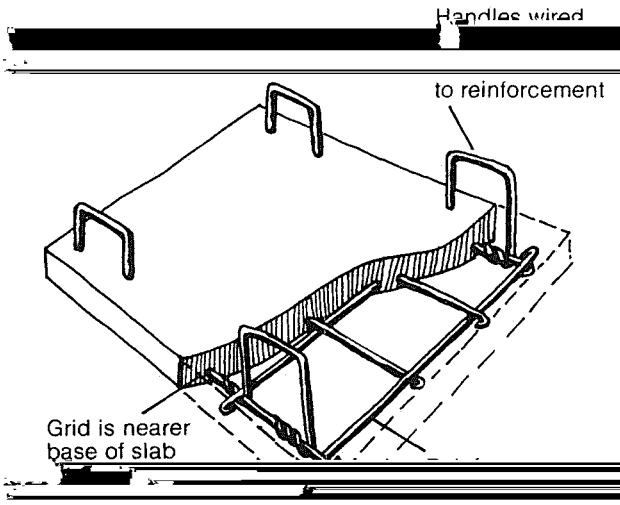
Each spring is, of course, a special case, but building an intake box is one method of protecting a spring from contamination.





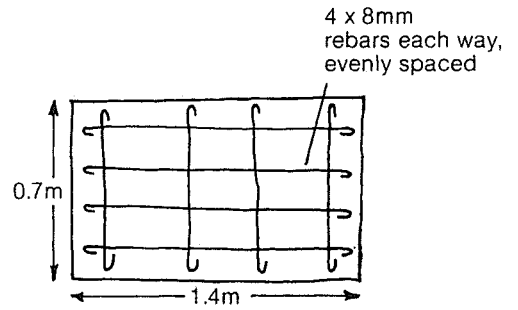
